**TO UTILIZE THE
MRT CALL:**

Parent/Guardian verbal consent **MUST** be obtained prior to initiating the Mobile Response Team.

**WHEN CALLING, BE
PREPARED TO:**



- ✓ Identify yourself and school you are calling from
- ✓ Provide student contact information
- ✓ State you need a MRT Clinician to respond

The Mobile Response Team (MRT) is available around-the-clock 24/7/365 to provide de-escalation strategies to students.

The MRT:

- Responds to requests within a 60-minute timeframe
- Provides behavioral health crisis-oriented services that are responsive to the individual and family needs
- Responds to crisis in the location in which it is occurring

REMEMBER:

In the case of an emergency or if a student is in imminent danger, CALL 911!

If abuse, neglect or abandonment is suspected, it is mandatory to make a report to the abuse hotline at 1-800-962-2873 or online at www.MyFLFamilies.com. Upon completion of the report with the hotline, school based administration must be notified of report in accordance with School Board Policy 2.80.
